## Process:

1) Students & parents will have a chance to meet with a volunteer clinician to review screening results

2) A care coordinator/family resource facilitator will help connect family to appropriate resources

3) Community organizations and behavioral health agencies will be able to promote services. Families will have time to visit and make appointments with providers that would be a good fit for assisting with diagnosis, treatment and follow-up care.
