Class Application

Semester 1: NAL - This class has been created for students interested in trying out for our school's NAL team. Students will have fun learning the rules of the game, competing against each other in practice games, and learning/reviewing English, Math, History, Science, and Geography concepts. Students will hone their memorization and public speaking skills and prepare for tryouts.

Semester 2: Advanced NAL - This class will be invitation only, and will be reserved for students who were selected to be on the team. Students will prepare and practice for upcoming games and will participate in a variety of team-building activities.

National Academic League (NAL) is a fun and competitive team sport! You'll get to use the concepts you've learned in your core classes to beat another team to the buzzer. There are 4 unique quarters of play (for a more detailed description of each quarter, please go to <u>https://cjhnal.weebly.com/the-game.html</u>):

- 1st Quarter: Both teams fight for possession of a rotating 3 question sequence.
- 2nd Quarter: Complex questions are solved in small groups. A team captain will attempt to buzz in and provide the group's answer before the other team.
- 3rd Quarter: A specialized team presents a solution to a modern day problem using evidence and visual aides.
- 4th Quarter: One player will face a player on the other team in a buzzer question competition. If both players fail to answer their question correctly, the remaining starting players on both teams get a chance to answer in an intense free-for-all lightning round.

Here are the time frames for some important parts of the NAL season: Late October: Tryouts November and December: After school practices on Tuesdays and Thursdays January and February: Practices and Games on Tuesdays and Thursdays

March: National Championship Games if we win the District Championship

In our school's 8-year history, we've had a ton of success in NAL: two 2nd place and two 1st place District Championship trophies, along with various team and individual scorer awards. If you want to be a part of that success, this is the class for you!
